Course Description

Students will:

- explore the APE online community
- chat with APE professionals from around the nation
- discuss case studies pertaining to APE competencies and proficiencies (i.e., knowledge, skills, duties, and responsibilities)
- review downloadable materials covering APENS content
- prepare for the APENS examination with quiz questions based on previously used exams

Students planning to enroll in this course should purchase (and begin to review) the **Adapted Physical Education National Standards** manual before class begins.
